You missed a fantastic October Association Meeting

The PE board always holds its fall semiannual meeting on the 2nd Tuesday in October at the Newburg Library. While association members receive an update on all current, past and future initiatives, the main thrust is a financial accounting of the previous 12 months income and expenditures. Don't ever be swayed by rumors of inequities. We believe in full transparency and provide a detailed, check by check accounting over a 12 month period. Home owners were afforded the opportunity to ask questions and offer suggestions. The board has launched an ongoing delinquency collection campaign that produced the critical income to pay for the pavilion roof expenditures.

Issues of Concern

- We have had a spike in crime over the last 10 months. Car break-ins dominate the crime in PE however home break-ins, including 1 home invasion, are included in our history. Be vigilant. Don't hesitate to call 911 and report suspicious behavior.
- Parking on the street is still a problem. We encourage YOU! to park your cars/trucks in your driveways. There is too much parking on the street which makes it difficult for some people to pass. If your car/truck is parked in front of your mailbox, the postman will not leave your mail.
- Snow removal time may be coming soon. We don't plow less than 4 inches. If warm weather is forecast soon following a snowfall, the streets may not get plowed regardless of depth. You should move your vehicles off the street anytime snow or ice is in the forecast. The salting of our streets is a decision which considers multiple factors, made by a consensus of multiple board
